The IAEG and the ISEG

It was at the XXII IGC (International Geological Congress) at New Delhi in December 1964 that the engineering geological fraternity attending the IGC gave due credence to the global surge in engineering geological activities and initiated the proposal of a Commission or an International Organisation in Engineering Geology. A group of "Eight" with Mr A. Shadmon of Israel as the main initiator, and leading Indian engineering geologists like Shri M.S. Balasundaram and V.S. Krishnaswamy of the GSI onboard, took the initiative that in due course led to the creation of the International Association for Engineering Geology. Affiliated to the International Union of Geological Sciences (IUGS), and associated with the Federation of International Geoengineering Societies (FedIGS), the IAEG is a renowned international organization. The IAEG unites the national engineering geological organisations and keeps serving the global society with iconic features like the Bulletin of Engineering Geology, four-yearly International Congresses, frequent Regional Engineering Geological Conferences,

The ISEG was inaugurated on 15 October 1965 in the premises of the GSI at the erstwhile Calcutta by an eminent engineer and the then

Union Minister for Irrigation and Power Dr KL Rao. Following the mandate contained in the Articles and Bylaws of the Society, the torch bearers donned the mantle of the serious crusaders and proactively engaged themselves in the dissemination of geoscientific information through publications and deliberations at various events. The ISEG carries on its rich heritage and keeps serving as a formidable bridge between geologists and engineers; provides vibrant platform for discussions and debate on a host of geotechnical problems and state-of-the-art technologies; and projects the nation's achievements in the field of geotechniques and allied expertise.

The ISEG takes pride in having hosted IAEG sponsored events, viz. the prestigious 4th International Congress of IAEG at New Delhi in 1982; 8th Asian Regional Conference of IAEG at Bangalore in 2011; and Golden Jubilee International Conference EGNM at New Delhi in the year 2015. The proposed EGCON 2025 is a testimony to the ISEG's efforts in keep bringing the international engineering geological fraternity together for vibrant deliberations on the development in the industry and academia.

Keynote Lectures

It is proposed to dedicate the first day of the Conference to the Keynote Lectures that would invite full attention of the delegates attending the EGCON 2025. If required, a few keynote lectures shall be accommodated between parallel sessions. The list of Keynote Speakers shall be announced in the subsequent releases from the Organising Committee.

Abstracts and Full Papers

The invitation for extended abstracts shall be rolled out on 01 August 2024. The abstract submission shall be online. The authors of accepted abstracts shall have the opportunity to make oral/ poster presentations during the Conference. The authors of accepted abstracts shall be invited to submit full papers starting 01 January 2025. While the extended abstracts shall be published and released during the conference, the full papers shall be peer reviewed and published in a post-conference special publication.









The Venue

The EGCON 2025 shall be held at the India Habitat Centre, New Delhi, a prestigious convention center in New Delhi. The campus weaves in a unique interplay of institutions, supporting infrastructure and facilities such as conference venues, auditoria, hospitality areas, the library, resource centre, and art galleries. Pre-Conference Delhi Tour
